**Average living expenses in Canberra in Australian Dollars**

Renting a room in a share house	\$ 100 – 150 per week (depending on suburb)
Groceries	\$ 50 – 75 per week (depending on your own preferences)
Transport costs	Bus trips (regardless of where you're going): <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Single trip Concession \$ 1,50 (concession applies when you have an International Student Identity Card, see <a href="http://www.isic.org">www.isic.org</a> for more info)</li><li>- Single Trip Normal \$ 3,00</li><li>- Concession Fare Saver (10 rides) \$ 11,00 or \$ 8,20 for weekdays only</li><li>- Normal Fare Saver (10 rides) \$ 22,00</li></ul>

Generally, costs for meals, accommodation, clothes and others are between \$1200 and \$1350 per month.
